Jesus lingers with His followers for 40 days following His resurrection. So how might we make the most of the time He is with us?

*Let him easter in us,
be a dayspring
to the dimness of us,
be a crimson-cressted east...
– Poet Gerard Manly Hopkins*

“Let him easter in us...” wrote the poet Gerard Manly Hopkins, who turned the word “easter” into a verb and captured the hope and joy that Christ’s resurrection makes possible. So how should we live in light of the life, death and resurrection of Jesus?

The first generation of followers of Jesus wondered the same thing. Jesus’ resurrection changed everything. So the risen Christ lingered another 50 days after Easter to help His followers understand everything He had said and done in that new light. It became a busy time of learning (and re-learning). 


