something, to "hold in trust." To be a person of trust. The meanings are many. And as I ponder the changes ahead for me this year, they will require trust in big doses.

Trust will play a big role in our church life, too, as the search for a new pastor begins. We've "entrusted" that process to a group of people. We are trusting that God is guiding someone even now who will come to lead this fellowship into its next chapter.

I taped this year's star of "trust" to the side of my computer screen beneath three star words from earlier years. Only as I wrote this article did it dawn on me -- trust was serving as a foundation for everything else.

That insight is fitting for this new season of the year: Epiphany. An epiphany is an "aha" moment. If you've ever had a sudden flash of insight, you've had an "epiphany" -- it means "to be revealed," or "to make known." The "light comes on" for us; what had been hidden is now revealed.

Talk with one another about the words you received. Share with each other what you're discovering through the light of that word. Imagine the light of this word shining over you this year. But also shining beneath you, guiding your steps and leading to you to discover Jesus in a fresh way for yourself.

May you discover this to be the first of many words from heaven itself that offer you light to guide your steps and lead you to see God is with you – and in you each day throughout this new year. See you Sunday.






