This month, our Heritage family of faith kicks off our monthlong Global Missions emphasis by hosting another Operation Inasmuch "Food Pack" on Saturday morning, September 24. We'll need a minimum of 75 volunteers for the morning to pack the dried ingredients for 20,000 hearty bowls of soup.

This year's "Food Pack" takes on extra special meaning – the bags of soup we prepare will be shipped to help feed people in war-torn Ukraine.

While the work is serious, the way we do it is fun! Working together on 10 assembly lines, we will combine dried ingredients into soup bags that will make up 20,000+ meals in about four hours. Who knew something so miraculous could be so much fun? Just ask those who shared in a previous "Food Pack" events.






