(Psalm 16; Mark 12:41-44)

Message: “Remembering to Say Thanks”

(Psalm 126; Matthew 6:25-33)

The holiday for giving thanks actually arose out of a time of great loss and hardship. At a time when worry and fear could have dominated their lives, they instead chose gratitude. Jesus reminds us that we are surrounded by great gifts of beauty and wonder. When hardship looms large in our lives, remembering to say thanks can remind us anew what is really important to see and remember.

Powerful magic

Parents often remind their children that “please” and “thank you” are “magic words.” During these weeks leading up to the annual Thanksgiving holiday, we’ll take time to reflect on the magic found in expressing gratitude to God and others.

Magic: “an extraordinary power or influence seemingly from a supernatural source.” That dictionary definition could also be a way of describing gratitude. Think about it. Gratitude has extraordinary power — it can literally change relationships, change the way we view circumstances, even brighten our gloomy mood.

Saying thanks is more than being polite. It is a way of “seeing” and reflecting on the miracle of the life we lead. The old hymn has it right: “count your many blessings/name them one by one;/count your many blessings,/see what God hath done.”

Henry Ward Beecher, a 19th century congregational minister and author, said a thankful heart acts like a magnet, attracting God’s miracles to it:

“If one should give me a dish of sand and tell me there were particles of iron in it, I might look for them with my eyes and search for them with my clumsy fingers and be unable to detect them; but let me take a magnet and sweep through it and now would it draw to itself the almost invisible particles by the mere power of attraction. The unthankful heart, like my finger in the sand, discovers no mercies; but let the thankful heart sweep through the day and as the magnet finds the iron, so it will find, in every hour, some heavenly blessings – only the iron in God’s sand is gold!”

What invisible particles cling to the magnet of your heart? You just may discover that the little you find is magical enough to become a lot. See you Sunday!

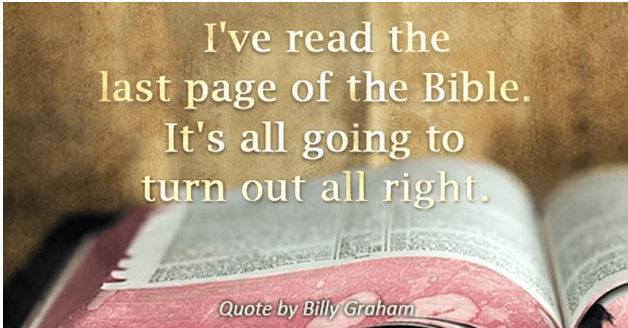
